- Order books when requested, based on grant or other funding.
- Build partnerships with local book sellers to ensure steady flow of high-quality books.
- Complete necessary data collection and evaluation.
- Attend weekly staff meetings and other meetings upon request.
- Help oversee the Reading Foundation's book drives.
- Complete necessary data collection.
