OUR PROGRAMS

- **Literacy Outreach Visits** - visits low-income housing units, schools, afterschool programs, community events and rural areas to promote reading by distributing 26,000+ free books and literacy materials.
- **Literacy Bookshelves** - stocks 23,400+ books in schools and on bookshelves at agencies serving low-income clients so children can take a free book home to read.
- **Bag O' Books** - packs individual book orders totaling 2,500+ books for families in Thurston and Mason counties, ordered online and picked up at our office.

- **Family Education** - visits parenting groups, support groups, workshops and literacy nights to provide books and discuss reading, literacy, and brain development.
- **Books for Babies** - gives 2,100+ new board books and literacy information to families leaving the hospital with newborns.
- **Born to Read** - partners with medical providers to give board books and information to low-income families at their baby's 6-month checkup.


- **Read to Me** - shares story time visits and 7,300+ free books with children ages 3-5 at Head Start and other childcare facilities monthly.
- **Phonics Friends-Direct Reading Support** - matches trained volunteers with students facing challenges in reading proficiency.
- **Reading Maps** - shares fun reading maps with children and families during school breaks to keep children engaged.


